SB 168 (BOWEN), CHAPTER 720, STATUTES OF 2001

Affects: State and Local Agencies That Use Social Security Numbers on Public Documents

Subject: Identity Theft; Social Security Numbers

Summary: Only section 7 of this legislation may affect our department. The legislation puts restrictions on the state's use of Social Security Account Numbers in order to ensure personal privacy. The legislation provides that a state or local agency may use SSNs for internal verification and administrative purposes, so long as the SSNs are not released to unauthorized persons.

AB 530 (REYES), CHAPTER 845, STATUTES OF 2001

Affects: Medi-Cal recipients in unlicensed care
Department of Justice

Subject: Adult and Elder Abuse

Summary: This legislation amended the Welfare and Institutions Code to permit Medi-Cal recipients in unlicensed care receiving in-home supportive services to receive criminal history information about the persons providing the in-home services.
